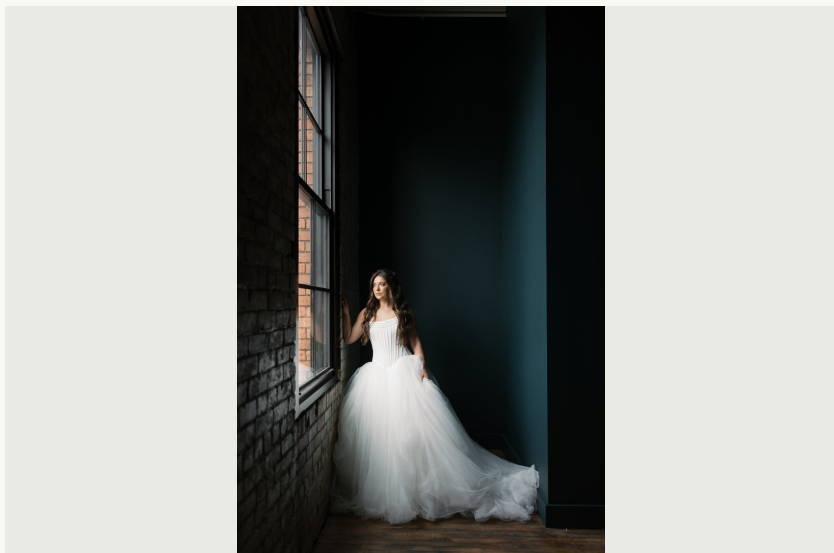

Use the entrance off the alley between Erie and Huron for easier access.

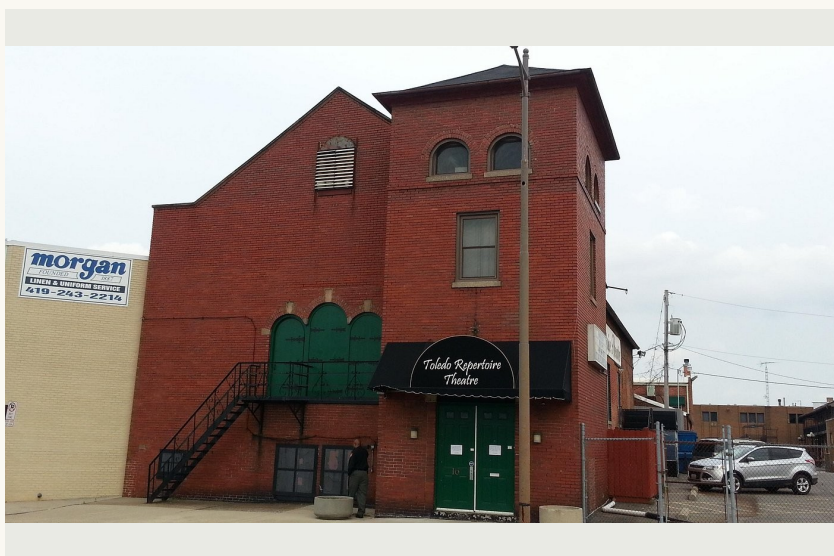
Discover a gathering spot taking shape in the growing Huron Yards development, where plans for The Station Sports Bar add to downtown's dining and entertainment scene.
